Queens Diamond Jubilee Celebration. To commemorate the Jubilee, the Chairman and fellow councillors presented china mugs to all the pupils and staff of Llangain school at their Jubilee party. The mugs have the Community Council emblem on one side and the Queens Jubilee picture on the other.
